JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the Plaintiff's Motion for a Default Judgment and the Court entering an Order granting Default Judgment, and after reviewing all of the records and court file, and it being determined that Judgment should be awarded in favor of the Plaintiff, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff, TREY MARIE VINEYARDS, LLC, is hereby awarded Judgment against the Defendants, TRILLIUM CORPORATION, INC., a Washington corporation, and DAVID R. SYRE, jointly and severally, in the total amount of \$973,992.95, which shall bear interest at the statutory rate of twelve percent (12%) from and after the date of this Order. It is further

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ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Plaintiff's Deed of Trust covering the following described real estate in Walla Walla County, Washington, which Deed of Trust was recorded on December 2, 2005 under Auditor's No. 2005-15050, is hereby adjudged to be a first and paramount lien upon said real property, and the whole thereof as security for Plaintiff's Judgment; and that such Deed of Trust may at the Plaintiff's discretion be foreclosed, and the property herein described shall be sold by the Sheriff of Walla Walla County in the manner prescribed by law, and the proceeds thereof shall be applied to the payment of Plaintiff's Judgment as set forth above, together with any increased taxes, assessments, costs, and interest, said real property being described as follows:

It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all right, title, claim, or interest of all of the Defendants, or any of them, and all persons claiming by, through, or under them, or any of them, subsequent to the date of Plaintiff's Deed of Trust, in and to the real estate herein described, or any part thereof, including the right to possession thereof under a Lease or otherwise, is inferior and subordinate to Plaintiff's mortgage lien and is hereby foreclosed and barred, except only for the statutory right of redemption allowed

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by law, to be exercised within eight months from the date of sale if there is no deficiency, and twelve months from the date of sale if there is a deficiency. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Plaintiff, TREY MARIE

VINEYARDS, LLC, a Washington limited liability company, is permitted to become a bidder and purchaser at the sale, and when the sale is completed, the purchaser shall have immediate possession subject only to the redemption rights allowed by law. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all taxes and assessments with respect to the real property foreclosed, which are paid by the Plaintiff between the time of the entry of this judgment and the sheriff's sale, shall act as a charge to the judgment, with said amounts, plus interest at the rate specified in this judgment, to be added to the judgment to increase the sales price, with the Plaintiff to file an affidavit as to the total amount of such increase as of the date of the sale. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Plaintiff shall be entitled to make further request to this court for attorney fees as incurred, and if any such fees are granted, said amount shall be added to the judgment amount granted herein. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this is final judgment pursuant to Superior Court Civil Rule 54(b) and as such Plaintiff is entitled to immediately pursue the remedy of sale as ordered herein.
