SEAWATER INTRUSION DRINKING WATER STATUS REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence, acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County (S.C.) Resolution #15570 signed December 12, 1994. This parcel is located in a Seawater Intrusion Area. The owners of this parcel must follow Interim Resolution #15570 or its successor.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. The drinking water source for this single-family residence is a 60.6-foot well drilled sometime after 1920 and before 1992. The well is located less than 1/2 mile from the coastline. According to the owners, the well was drilled as far inland as possible. The owners showed documentation that a 5 gpm pump restrictor and a wellhead source meter were installed.
4. The 11.04.08 well sample measured 91 ppm chlorides, 63.5 ppm sodium, and conductivity of 629 uS/cm. (Home water softeners that add additional sodium to the water are not recommended for this water.) While no MCL has been established for sodium, 200 mg/l is the maximum level recommended for Healthy adults. High levels of sodium may cause health problems for infants and people with cardiac, circulatory or renal diseases. The American Heart Association recommends a maximum level of 20 mg/l for individuals needing to reduce their salt intake. Resolution #15570 requires the property owner to:
  - a. utilize a maximum pumping rate of 5 gallons per minute or less.
  - b. record the static water levels annually in September.
  - c. record the chloride test results in September annually.
  - d. record the well head meter readings annually in September.
  - e. all reasonable water conservation measures shall be utilized.
 These records shall be submitted to the Skagit County Health Department. This data will be used for educational purposes only and not for enforcement action.
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health or Permit Center. (WA08-0124)
