SEAWATER INTRUSION DRINKING WATER STATUS REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence, acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County (S.C.) Resolution #15570 signed December 12, 1994. This parcel is located in a **Seawater Intrusion Area**. The owners of this parcel must follow Interim Resolution #15570 or its successor.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.

 I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.

- 3. The drinking water source for this single-family residence is a 500'-foot well drilled January 13, 2010. The well (BAK 077) is located less than 1/2 mile from the coastline on P#67181 for the sole residential use of P#67186 (See Exhibit A map). According to the owners, the well was drilled as far inland as possible. The owners showed documentation that a 1 gpm pump restrictor, sounding tube and a wellhead source meter were installed.
- 4. The April 8, 2010 well sample measured 44 ppm chlorides and 37.9 ppm sodium. Home water softeners that add additional sodium to the water are not recommended for this water. After review by the County Hydro-geologist, Resolution #15570 requires the property owner to:
 - a. utilize a maximum pumping rate of 1 gallon per minute or less,
 - b. record the static water levels annually in September, quarterly for the first year in use,
 - c. record the chloride test results, prior to treatment if any, in September annually,
 - d. record the well head meter readings monthly for the first year of residence and annually thereafter,
 - e. all reasonable water conservation measures shall be utilized.

These records shall be submitted to the Skagit County Health Department. This data will be used for educational purposes only and not for enforcement action.

5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot may be on file at the Skagit County Department of Health or Permit Center. (WA09-0018)
