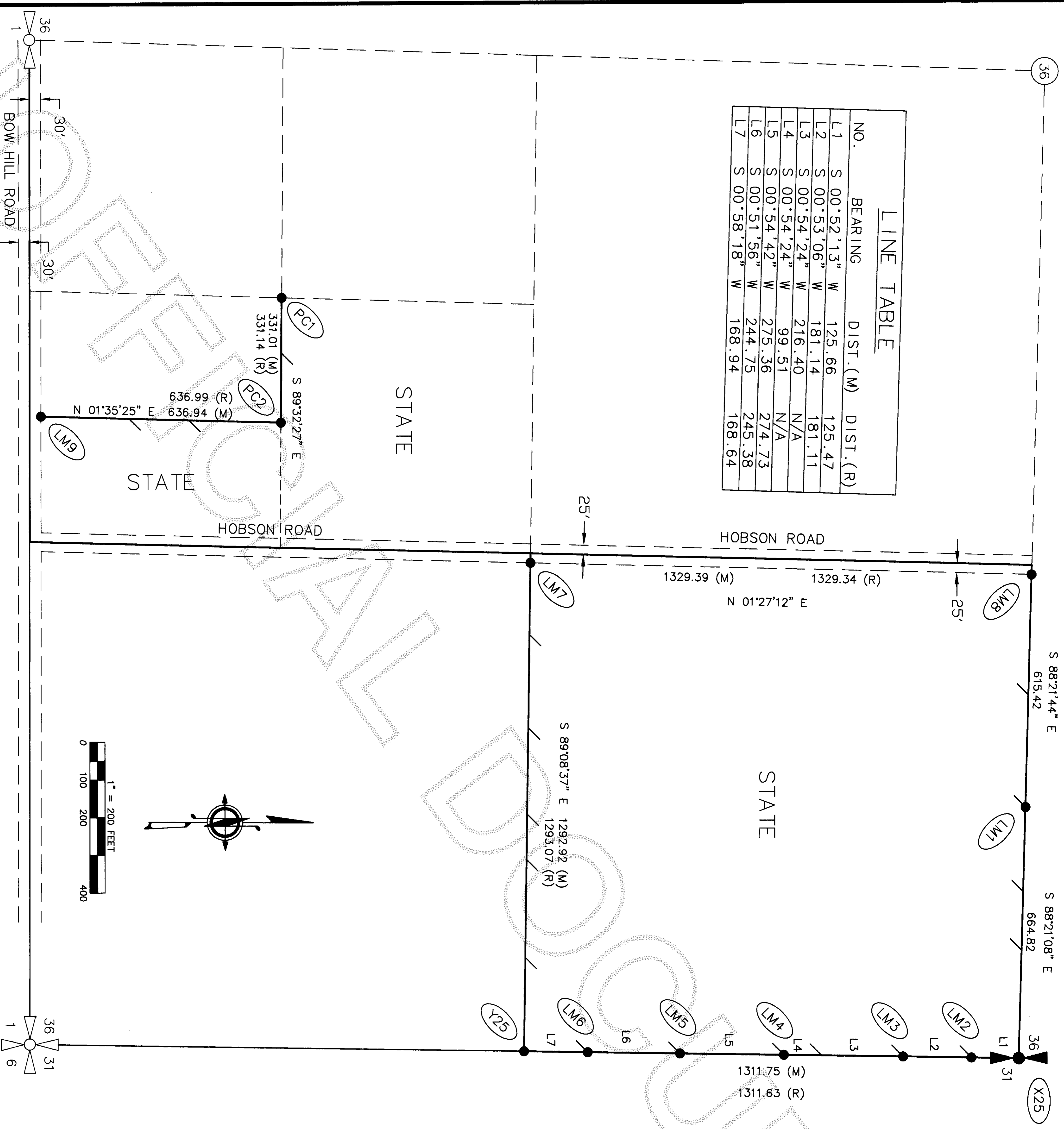

BASIS OF BEARINGS AND DISTANCES
 THE BASIS OF BEARINGS IS N01°27'12"E FOR THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTER LINE OF THE SE 1/4 OF SECTION 36. THIS IS IN HOLDING WITH THE BEARING DEPICTED ON THE RECORD OF SURVEY RECORDED UNDER AFN 9304280051, DATED 4-28-1993, RECORDS OF THE SKAGIT COUNTY AUDITOR. DISTANCES SHOWN ARE GROUND DISTANCES.

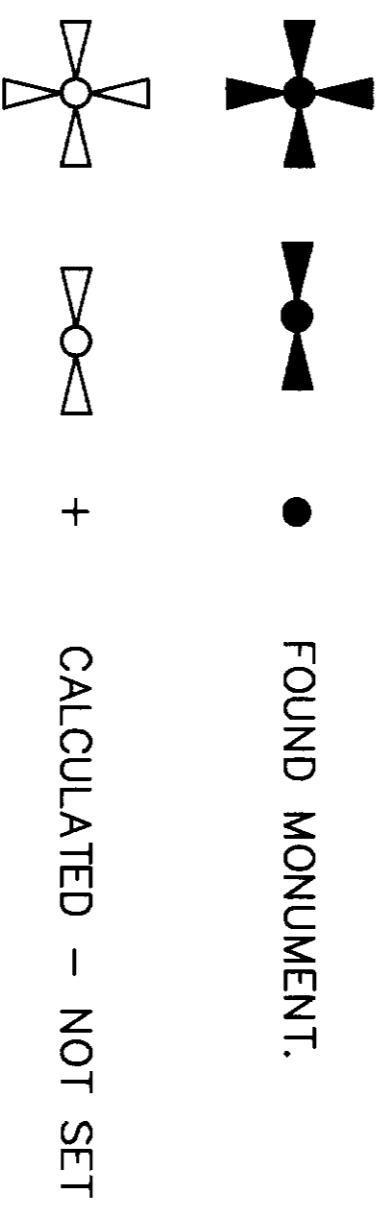
CONTROL SPECIFICATIONS, METHOD OF SURVEY, EQUIPMENT USED AND ACCURACY

CORNER TIES WERE MADE BY FIELD TRAVERSE USING A LEICA TORA 1203+ ELECTRONIC THEODOLITE. THE 100-LINE IS A CLOSED LOOP AROUND THE NE 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4. THE 200-LINE IS A POINT TO POINT TRAVERSE BEGINNING AT LM9, TYING PC2 AND ENDING AT PC1. CORNER MONUMENTS AND LINE MONUMENTS WERE TIED BY DOUBLE MEASURES OF BOTH DIRECTION AND DISTANCE. THE TRAVERSERS MEET THE STANDARDS FOR RURAL TRAVERSES AS SPECIFIED IN WAC 332-130-090. THE TRAVERSERS WERE ADJUSTED USING THE LEAST SQUARES COMPUTER APPLICATION KNOWN AS STAR*NET, STANDARD EDITION - VERSION 6.0.

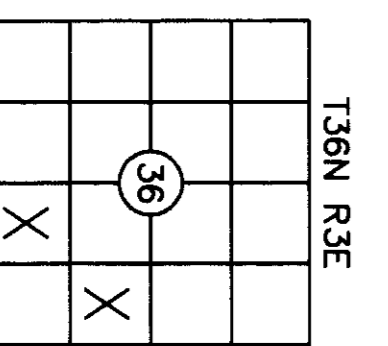
NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO POST CERTAIN STATE BOUNDARY LINES IN SECTION 36 TO SERVE THE 'HOBSON CEDAR' TIMBER SALE. ALL THE NECESSARY MONUMENTS WERE ACCEPTED AS FOUND AND NO NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET. FOR INFORMATION ABOUT THE FULL SECTION SUBDIVISION, SEE SKAGIT SURVEYORS' RECORD OF SURVEY RECORDED UNDER AFN 9304280051. BOUNDARY LINES BETWEEN CORNERS, INCLUDING EXISTING LINE MONUMENTS, WERE POSTED WITH ONE-INCH-WIDE BY SIX-FOOT-LONG ORANGE FIBERGLASS 'THIN-LINE' POSTS SET AS SHOWN ON THE MAP. ALL POSITIONS OF LINE POST SYMBOLS ARE TO SCALE. THREE-INCH-WIDE BY SIX-FOOT-LONG ORANGE CARSONITE WITNESS POSTS WERE PLACED ALONGSIDE CORNER MONUMENTS. NO NEW REFERENCING WAS DONE.

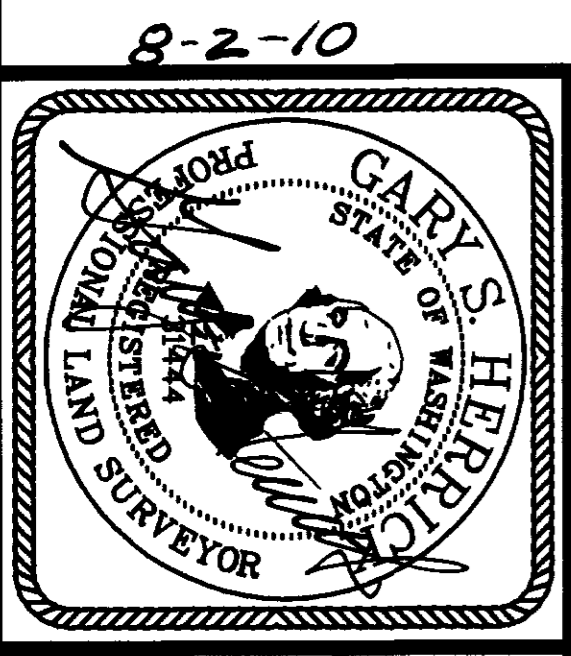
