## WATER SERVICE CONTRACT

This Contract is entered into this day of <u>December</u>, 2010, between Public Utility District No. 1 of Skagit County, hereinafter referred to as the "District" and VICTOR L. BENSON AND LINDA C. BENSON, husband and wife, or their successor or assigns, hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant" and DAVE NEEDY or his successor or assigns, hereinafter referred to as the "Customer".

The Applicant and Customer are entering into this Contract to secure a water service(s) for the property located at 20392 Benson Ridge Lane, Mount Vernon, Washington. The construction of the residence located at the above address was allowed per building permit number BP 10-0134. The parcel is located in the NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 33 N, Range 4 E, under Auditors File Number 200906100089, Parcel Number 128561. The District owns and operates a water distribution system near the location of the proposed service(s) and is willing to supply water to the Applicant and Customer under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. This single water service is for the single family residence, at address 20392 Benson Ridge Lane, located on lot number 4 of Saratoga Passage View C.A.R.D., Auditors File Number 200906100089, and is the only water service that will be allowed for PL 06-0107 prior to acceptance of the project by the District. This Agreement will remain in effect until all work necessary for a complete and functioning water system has been completed, tested, and accepted by the District.
- 2. Meter installation costs. The Applicant shall be responsible for paying all costs associated with installing water services to the water system as required by the District Water Policy Manual, Appendix A, Table A-8.
- 3. The cost of water shall be at the current water rate schedule at the time of each billing.
- 4. The District shall not be liable to the Applicant or the Applicant's agent(s) or the Customer for damages, breach of Contract, or for interruption of service or curtailment of supply for any cause. The Applicant and Customer shall hold the District harmless from any claim for damages by third parties, to the extent that the claim arises out of Applicant's or Customers negligence.
- 5. The Applicant and Customer agrees that if problems arise related to water system source capacity or hydraulics, water for irrigation or other non-domestic demands can be limited or discontinued. Water for irrigation is recommended during, and may be limited to, "off peak" hours of 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. each day, or such hours as the District may prescribe. The Applicant and Customer agrees to adhere to such limitations or recommendations as a condition of service.
- 6. The Applicant and Customer recognize that all water will contain chlorinous compounds which are dangerous to aquatic life. Depending on hydraulic flows within the distribution system, pH levels may exceed 10. The Applicant and Customer shall pursue, with reasonable diligence, the protection of aquatic life onsite and offsite of the Applicant's property and, upon failure to do so, shall hold the District harmless from any damages arising therefrom.
- 7. Water quality may vary in the future due to the result(s) of the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act or other requirements.
- 8. The Applicant and Customer agree to install and to maintain a backflow prevention assembly approved for installation in Washington State on all irrigation service(s) and on such other water service(s) as may be required by the District and State/federal health authorities. The type and model of assembly(ies) necessary must be approved by the District.
- 9. Compliance with this Contract shall be a condition of service through this meter(s) and shall be binding upon Applicant's and Customers successors or assigns. Increases in water volumes, meter sizes, meter quantities, and other material changes in water demand or ownership data shall be documented in a written amendment(s) to, or rewriting of, this Contract.
- 10. Applicant and/or Customers non-compliance with this Contract shall result in cancellation of service.
