Location: Located along, and north of, Helmick Road on a 6.93 acre site described as Lot 3 of Short Plat #37-89 (AF#8910270018). The site is owned by the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, adjacent to the Helmick Road Reservation, and is approximately 750 feet east of the Nuwha-Ah Lane and Helmick Road intersection, north of 26024 Helmick Road, Sedro-Woolley, within a portion of Section 9, Township 35N, Range 5 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. Land Use Designation: Rural Reserve (RRv)

Summary of Proposal: Administrative Special Use Permit request (#PL12-0056) for the installation of approximately 550 lineal feet of 8 inch ductile iron water line to be installed 10 feet east of the western boundary of the Bonneville Power Administration easement. The purpose of the proposed water line is to improve pressure distribution and fire flow within the Helmick Road Reservation by providing a water line loop from the northern to the southern areas within the Reservation.

Public Hearing: Not required per SCC 14.06.050(1)(a)(vii)
Decision/Date: The application is approved, subject to conditions, dated **April 13, 2012.**
