Commencing at the initial point of said Tract 1 of Section 23; thence West 308 feet; thence South 70 degrees 44' West 855 feet; thence South 23 degrees East 112 feet; thence North 69 degrees 10' East 136 feet; thence North 70 degrees 83' East 533.5 feet; thence North 73 degrees 12' East 444 feet; thence North 17 degrees 45' East 32 feet to beginning.

Commencing at the initial point of Tract 1, Plate 7, said Section 23; thence South 17 degrees, 45' West, 32 feet; thence South 73 degrees, 12' West 444 feet; thence South 70 degrees, 53' West, 533 5/10 feet; thence South 69 degrees, 10' West 136 feet; thence North 22 degrees, no minutes West, 40 feet; thence Easterly in a direct line a distance of 970 feet to a point in Tract 1, Plate 7, Section 23, which point is 40 feet Northwesterly measured at right angles, to the second course herein described; thence Northwesterly in a direct line a distance of 200 feet, more or less, to a point which bears North 17 degrees, 45' East, 66 feet from the initial point of lot one, Tract 1, Section 23; thence South 17 degrees, 45' West, 66 feet to the place of beginning.
