 - 3) Use a typewriter or ballpoint pen to fill out this form to assure good copies. Print clearly. Remove the instruction sheet at this perforation—Do not remove any other sheets or carbons.

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General Information

Registration of a Water Right Claim is not required in the following instances:

- 1) Individuals who are served water through a water company, district, public or municipal corporation (the entity should file one or more claims for all users)
- 2) Individuals with a valid Water Right Permit or recorded Certificate issued by this department, the Department of Water Resources, Department of Conservation or other predecessor agencies.
- 3) Individuals with a water right determined by court decree and recorded through issuance of a Certificate of Water Right by this department or one of its predecessor agencies.
- 4) Where waters are used for such nonconsumptive purposes as boating, swimming, or other recreational and aesthetic use, and there is no physical diversion or artificial impoundment of such waters.
- 5) Where livestock drink directly from a surface water source.

Who Should File:

Basically anyone who is using water or has used water in the past and does not fit one of the above categories should register a claim to water right unless the use has not been legal, in which case an application for water right should be filed rather than a claim registered. A general category table is provided on the reverse side of this sheet to assist you in this determination.

FAILURE TO REGISTER A CLAIM BY JUNE 30, 1974, AS REQUIRED BY LAW, WILL RESULT IN A WAIVER AND RELINQUISHMENT OF THE CLAIMED WATER RIGHT.

Additionally, the State Cooperative Extension Service has an agent in each county, generally at the courthouse, who has knowledge sufficient to assist in the completion of these claim forms and will help you.

Definitions

- 1) Ground water sources are those where water does not naturally appear on the surface of the earth, which includes but are not limited to wells, sumps, and infiltration trenches or galleries.
- 2) Surface water sources are those where water appears naturally on the surface of the earth, and include but are not limited to creeks, streams, rivers, lakes, springs, ponds or swamps.
- 3) Riparian lands are those abutting upon a lake, stream or other watercourse; conversely, nonriparian lands are located away from such a watercourse.

Need For Filing A Water Right Claim: Do you or not you have a need to file a water right claim:

Water is now in use (or has been but use temporarily discontinued)	Source is ground water AND first use before 1945	File a Water Right Claim *
Water is now in use (or has been but use temporarily discontinued)	Source is ground water AND first use is after 1945 AND withdrawal does not exceed 5,000 gallons per day AND if for lawn and garden, 1/2 acre or less is irrigated	File a Water Right Claim **
Water is now in use (or has been but use temporarily discontinued)	Source is surface water AND lands are nonriparian AND first use was made after 1917	Complete and submit a Surface Water Application
Water is now in use (or has been but use temporarily discontinued)	Source is ground water AND first use is after 1945 AND withdrawal exceeds 5,000 gallons per day OR more than 1/2 acre is irrigated	Complete and submit a Ground Water Application

*Through action by the 1973 Legislature, there are now two types of forms which may be used in filing water right claims. A "short form" may be used in all cases where the water use does not exceed 5,000 gallons a day, except in those cases where the purpose of use is for commercial irrigation or for the watering of a lawn or a noncommercial garden exceeding one-half acre in area. A "standard claim form" should be requested from the department for use in filing all other claims.

**A "short form" may be used at all times in this situation.
