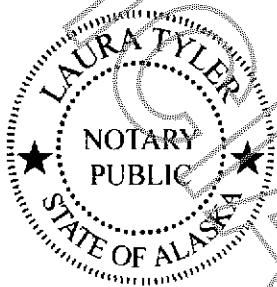

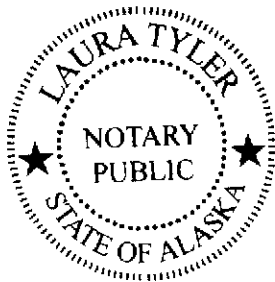

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION:**

**PARCEL "A":**

All that portion of Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, Township 35 North, Range 1 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington, described as follows:

Bounded on the North by a line 30 feet South of and parallel to the center line of Burlington Northern Inc. as now located and constructed.

Bounded on the West by a line parallel to and 23.10 feet distant Northeasterly, measured at right angles, from the extension of the lot lines between Lots 2 and 3, Block 1, "NORTHERN PACIFIC ADDITION TO ANACORTES," as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 9, records of Skagit County, Washington.

Bounded on the South by the South line of Burlington Northern Inc. right of way, as shown and designated on "NORTHERN PACIFIC ADDITION TO ANACORTES," as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 9, records of Skagit County, Washington (also known as the North line of said plat) and the "MAP OF THE CITY OF ANACORTES, SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON,"

TOGETHER WITH that portion of the Burlington Northern Railroad designated as reserve right of way for the Seattle and Northern Railroad as shown on the plat of "MAP OF THE CITY OF ANACORTES, SKAGIT COUNTY, WASHINGTON," as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 4, records of Skagit County, Washington.

TOGETHER WITH a portion of the Burlington Northern Railroad right of way designated as Northern Pacific Railroad on the plat of "NORTHERN PACIFIC ADDITION TO ANACORTES," as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 9, records of Skagit County, Washington, all being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 1 of said Plat of NORTHERN PACIFIC ADDITION TO ANACORTES;

thence South 58° 51' 30" West, a distance of 173.91 feet to the true point of beginning.

thence South 73° 12' West 444 feet;  
thence South 70° 53' West, 533 5/10 feet;  
thence South 69° 10' West 136 feet;  
thence North 22° 00" West, 40 feet;  
thence Easterly in a direct line a distance of 970 feet to a point in Tract 1, Plate 7, Section 23, which point is 40 feet Northwesterly measured at right angles, to the second course herein described;  
thence Northeasterly in a direct line a distance of 200 feet, more or less, to a point which bears North 17° 45' East, 66 feet from the initial point of Lot 1, Tract 1, Section 23;  
thence South 17° 45' West, 66 feet to the point of beginning.
