THIS MATTER comes before the Court on motion of the United States for entry of a Final Order of Forfeiture with respect to the following assets:

- A. Approximately Three Million Six Hundred Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty (3,609,820) Cigarettes of Assorted Brands, More or less, and any proceeds of any interlocutory sale of these cigarettes;
- B. \$80,893.71 in United States currency seized from the Trading Post at March Point Premises;
- C. \$38,171.96 in United States currency seized from the Trading Post at March Point premises;
- D. Real Properties in satisfaction of the money judgment in the amount of \$603,299.87:

On June 16, 2010, this Court entered Preliminary Orders of Forfeiture in the above-captioned case forfeiting defendants C. Marvin Wilbur, Joan C. Wilburn, April Wilburn, and Brenda Wilbur's interest in the above-listed property.

The above-referenced property was subject to forfeiture pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2344(c), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), based on the guilty pleas of defendants Conspiracy to Traffic in Contraband Cigarettes, as

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1 charged in Count One of the Second Superseding Indictment, in violation of Title 18,  
2 United States Code, Sections 2342 and 371, and Conspiracy to Launder Monetary  
3 Instruments, as charged in Count 19 of the Second Superseding Indictment, in violation  
4 of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956(h), and the Court's finding that the above  
5 described property is subject to forfeiture.

6 Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(n), the United States  
7 published notice on an official internet government forfeiture website,  
8 www.forfeiture.gov, starting on February 7, 2014 and running consecutively for thirty  
9 days until its conclusion on March 8, 2014. In the publication, the United States  
10 published notice of the Preliminary Order of Forfeiture and the intent of the United States  
11 to dispose of the property in accordance with law. This notice further stated that any  
12 person other than the defendant having or claiming an interest in the property was  
13 required to file a petition with the Court within sixty (60) days of the first date of  
14 publication of the notice, setting forth the nature of the petitioner's right, title, and  
15 interest in the property.

16 On March 11, 2014, and March 27, 2014, the United States sent notice of the  
17 Preliminary Order of Forfeiture filed against the Wilburs, via certified mail, to Laura B.  
18 Beard, Lenora F. Wilbur, Cook, Randall Cook, Fidalgo Bay Cigar Company, LLC, Salish  
19 Trust, Skagit Cigarette Sales Trust, Skagit State Bank.

20 On April 4, 2014, the Skagit State Bank filed a Motion to Adjudicate Its Interest in  
21 the property subject to forfeiture.

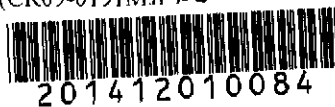
22 On July 11, 2014, this Court approved the Stipulated Settlement Agreement  
23 between the United States and Skagit Bank, in which the United States recognized  
24 Petitioner Skagit's Bank's interest in a portion of the currency seized from the Wilburs,  
25 \$8,042.29, and the real property known as Skagit County Parcel No. P59700.

26 All persons and entities believed to have an interest in the property subject to  
27 forfeiture were given proper notice of the intended forfeiture.

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1 No petitioners or claimants have come forth to assert an interest in the forfeited  
2 property, and the time for doing so has expired.

3 Accordingly,

4 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the following property is  
5 hereby fully and finally condemned and forfeited to the United States in its entirety:

The Clerk of the Court shall remit the proceeds of the sale of the interlocutory sale of the forfeited cigarettes described in paragraph A above, totalling \$202,710.00 in U.S. Currency, plus any and all interest accrued, less statutory authorized fees, to the United States Marshals Service.

The United States Marshals Service, and/or its agents and representatives, is authorized to dispose of the above-listed property in accordance with the law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that no right, title, or interest in the above-described property shall exist in any other party.

The Clerk of the Court is directed to send a copy of this Final Order of Forfeiture to all counsel of record.
