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**DRINKING WATER QUALITY SYSTEM REPORT**

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.270 in regards to a drinking water quality parameter that exceeds the maximum contaminant level but is treatable to below the maximum contaminant level.

1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
3. The drinking water source for this individual residential use well (BHX 590) is located in an area exhibiting fecal coliforms. The inorganic chemistry taken on October 22, 2014 had high levels of Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) 352mg/L, and per the applicant two failed bacteria results. The drinking water well on P36734 is vulnerable due to its shallow source and proximity to agricultural practices. The post treatment inorganic chemistry taken on March 26, 2015 had levels of 392 mg/L TDS, a typical 50.0mg/L increase profile for post softener treatment. Satisfactory fecal coliform results were taken February 23, 2015. Treatment is provided by a Water Right Sanitizer Plus ASP1-1054 system and a ultra-violet PURA UV20-3 SD/CB. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
  - a. This property may not be subdivided unless PUD#1 is available to all lots,
  - b. The building permit for the residence on P#26402 is conditioned upon treatment being provided for the water source that will treat fecal coliforms,
  - c. The property owner shall sample and maintain the treatment system to avoid adverse health effects as any untreated water is considered unsafe for consumption, and
  - d. The property owner shall abandon this water source as a source of potable water per WAC 173-160 and connect to PUD #1 when it becomes available.
4. Water systems with filed status reports will not be used for the creation of new lots.
5. Specific drinking water system information for this lot is on file at the Skagit County Planning and Permit Center. (WA14-0041)
