View Estates South Homeowners Association, constitutes a menace or danger to said line(s) or to persons or property by reason of proximity to the line(s).

Grantor, its heirs, successor or assigns hereby conveys and agrees not to construct or permit to be constructed structures of any kind on the easement area without written approval of the Sauk Mt. View Estates South Homeowners Association. Grantor shall conduct its activities and all other activities on Grantor's property so as not to interfere with, construct or endanger the usefulness of any improvements or other facilities, now or hereafter, maintained upon the easement or in any way interfere with, obstruct or endanger the City's use of the easement.

The Sauk Mt. View Estates South Homeowners Association may assign its rights under this easement to any municipality, public district or other entity.

Easements are granted to the City of Sedro-Woolley, Washington, a municipal corporation, its successors and assigns, the perpetual right, privilege and authority enabling the City to do all 22. things necessary or proper in the construction and maintenance of sewer, stormwater and communication line(s), and other municipal and public utilities or related facilities, including the right to construct, operate, maintain, inspect, improve, remove, restore, alter, replace, relocate, connect to and locate at any time a pipe or pipes, line or sewer, stormwater, and communication lines or other municipal and public facilities of other similar public services over, across, along, in and under the lands as shown on this Rlat, together with the right of ingress to and egress from said lands across adjacent lands of the Grantor; also, the right to cut and/or trim all brush or other growth standing or growing upon the land of the Grantor which, in the opinion of the City, constitutes a menace or danger to said line(s) or to persons or property by reason of proximity to the line(s).
