**NOTICE OF DECISION

- Applicant:** Skagit County Parks and Recreation, c/o Brian Adams,
Washington State Parks, c/o Jack Hartt,
- Request /File No:** Administrative Special Use Permit request (#PL15-0344)
- Location:** Located within easements extending from Donnell Road (adjacent to 13955 Donnell Road) south to the Washington State Deception Pass State Park property to connect to the existing trail, Anacortes, within a portions of Sections 12, 13, and 14, Township 34N, Range 1 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P19427, P19383, P19325, P19318 with easements over P19314, P19316, P19377, and P19328).
- Land Use Designation:** Rural Reserve (RRv) and Public Open Space of Regional/Statewide Importance (OSRSI)
- Summary of Proposal:** Administrative Special Use Permit request (#PL15-0344) submitted by Skagit County Parks and Recreation and Washington State Parks to extend the Pass Lake trail which currently connects the old Ginnett homestead to the Pass Lake parking lot.
- Public Hearing:** Not required per SCC 14.06.050(1)(a)(vii)
- Decision/Date:** The application is approved, subject to conditions, dated **October 5, 2015**
- Appeal:** As provided in SCC 14.06.110(7), the decision may be appealed to Skagit County Hearing Examiner by filing a written notice of appeal with Planning and Development Services within 14 days after the date of the decision.
