DRINKING WATER SYSTEM STATUS REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section (S. C. C.) 12.48.270. The alternative drinking water source is not a drilled well and requires filtration and disinfection treatment to be potable.

- 1. I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
- 2. I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search. We have no objection nor will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
- The drinking water source for this single family residence is a Rainwater Catchment 3. System. The source captures run-off from the building roofs, is stored in large tanks and is filtered and disinfected prior to use. The system was Engineered by Chris Webb P.E. of Herrera Environmental Consultants (220 Sixth Ave, Suite 100. Seattle, WA 98121 - Tel. # 206-441-9080). The Health Department requires both continuous filtration and disinfection to ensure the source is consistent and potable. The treatment system was installed as follows: a Pentek 50-5 micron sediment filter then to a Pentek 10 micron carbon filter for taste and odor, then to a Pentek micron filter and receives final disinfection through a Trojan UVMAX Model Pro10 Ultraviolet sterilized (10gpm). The Health Officer recommends that the property owners insure consistent potable water quality by following the maintenance recommendations provided by their Engineer Chris Webb P.E. in the Operations and Maintenance section (pages 49 & 20) of the Design Handbook and any additional recommendations of the systems installer Ken Blair.
- Properties with water systems with filed status reports will not be used as 4. justification for the creation of new lots and can not be further subdivided.
- Specific drinking water system information for this of may be on file at the Skagit County 5. Department of Health.

**Existing and future owners need to be aware that the Department of Ecology has agreed not to require decommission of the well (Tag AHH667) with the following statement on this recorded Status Report: The well (Tag# AHH667) must not be connected to any buildings and must not be used until a water right becomes available and is purchased from the Department of Ecology
