

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared an intention to become such, have discovered on November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016, a vein or lode of locatable mineral-bearing rock in place upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, have located and do hereby locate a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post or monument at the point of discovery. The name of the claim is: JK Stone Mine Claim, further described\* as follows:

Commencing at a post marked No. 1: At the Left Side of Cascade River Rd. 11 mile  
 then 894 feet in a EAST direction to a corner post marked No. 2,  
 then 894 feet in a NORTH direction to a corner post marked No. 3,  
 then 1788 feet in a West direction to a corner post marked No. 4,  
 then 894 feet in a South direction to that corner post marked No. 1.

The locators claim 894 feet in a EAST direction from the point of discovery to the Point of Discovery end line and 894  
894 feet in the opposite direction from the point of discovery to the South & North end line and  
894 feet on each side of the middle of the vein or lode, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.
