The notice shall also contain an offer to sell the Property to Grantor, or its successor in interest, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the bona fide offer. A copy of any documents evidencing such bona fide offer shall be included in the notice.

For a period of thirty (30) days after the receipt of the notice, Grantor, or its successor in interest, shall have the right to purchase the Property in accordance with the terms of the bona fide offer. If Grantor, or its successor in interest, fails to exercise the right of first refusal set forth in this covenant, the Grantees or Survivor may sell or convey the Property to the party making the bona fide offer, but only at the price and upon the terms specified in the notice. Should the terms of sale change, Grantor shall be provided an additional offer notice containing the

changed terms and/or conditions and shall have an additional thirty (30) day period in which to exercise its option to purchase the Property.

Nothing in this covenant shall prevent a sale or conveyance of the Property at any time provided the Grantees or Survivor receive the prior written approval of Grantor or its successor in interest.
