DRINKING WATER QUALITY SYSTEM REPORT

I, the undersigned property owner, in making an application for a building permit involving a single-family residence acknowledge that this notice is being signed, notarized and recorded in compliance with Skagit County Code Section 12.48.250 and SCC 12.48.270.

- I agree to record this notice with the Skagit County Auditor's Office for the purpose of it being made a part of the record of title.
- I understand that this notice will appear on any title search or record search, and we have no objection nor 2. will we make claims against Skagit County as a consequence of this recording.
- The drinking water source for this individual residential use is a dug well (ALNO97). The raw water sample 3. taken on 1-11-18 exhibited high levels of Total Dissolved Solids (TDS [86mg/L]) and Turbidity (18.3NTU) with an unsatisfactory Coliform result. The drinking water well on P103204 is vulnerable due to its shallow source. The post treatment/filtration sample results taken on 1-11-18 were TDS (94mg/L) and Turbidity (5.56 NTU) with a satisfactory Coliform result. Treatment is provided by two Watts SF10-20-425 twenty inch filters: 10 microns, a Watts SF20-10-425 ten inch filter 20 microns, a Whirlpool WHA4FF5 -1 micron filtration system and a Multi Chlor LMIA7 with 1,000 storage system.. The Health Officer recommends that property owners exercise caution in the use of this drinking water system by:
 - a. This property may not be subdivided unless public water or WAC 173-160 drilled wells are available to all
 - b. The building permit for the residence on P#106204 is conditioned upon treatment being provided for the water source that will provide satisfactory TDS, Turbidity, and bacteriological results,
 - c. The property owner shall sample and maintain the treatment system to avoid adverse health effects as any untreated water is considered unsafe for consumption, and
 - d. The property owner shall abandon this water source as a source of potable water per WAC 173-160 and connect to public water when it becomes available.
- 4. Water systems with filed status reports will not be used for the creation of new lots.
- Specific drinking water system information for this lot is on file at the Skagit County Planning and Development Services. (WA18-0007)
