

- I FOUND A CONCRETE MONUMENT IN A CASE WITH A 2" FLAT BRASS DISK AND DINCH MARK, THIS MONUMENT LIES M 3" 19" 2" E, 4.2% OF CALCULATED CENTER OF MAIN STREET AT THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE PLAT OF CENTRAL BAKER. THIS MONUMENT IS FOR THE PLAT OF LONESTAR'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF CONCRETE AND CONTROLS THE STREET TO THE WEST OF IT, BUT NOT TO THE EAST. THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF LOT 7 FELL 25'TO THE BAST OF THE RECORDED LOCATIONS. UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ALL OTHER CORNERS WERE FOUND WITHIN .1' OF RECORD.
