Legal Description

Portion of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 17, Township 35 North, Range 6 East, W.M., described as follows:
Beginning at a point on the West line of said subdivision 873 feet North of the Southwest corner thereof; thence East 120 feet; thence North to the Southwest corner thereof; thence East 120 feet; thence North of the South line of the Puget Sound and Beker Rivers tillney right-of-way; thence Westerly along South line of said right-of-way to the West line of said beginning.

All that portion of the abandoned Puget Sound and Baker River Railroad lying North of and odjacent to the following described tract: Beginning at a point 873 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of point 873 feet North of the Southwest corner of the North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence East 120 feet; thence North to the Puget Sound and Baker River Railway; thence West to a point North of the point of beginning. While the point of beginning the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 17, Township 35 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence Segmining at the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4, a Section 17, Township 35 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence Section 17, Township 35 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence S 0270318" W along the West line of said Northeast 1/4, a distance of 29,3.65 feet to the North right—of-way line of the Puget Sound and Baker River Railway conveyed by instrument recorded May 16, 1907; in Volume 82 of Deeds, page 369, records of Skagit County, Washington, as shown on survey filed in Volume 20 of Surveys at page 73, under Auditor's File No. 9802270078, records of Skagit County, Washington, and the point of beginning of this description: thence N 5626;13" E. a distance of 43.95 feet; thence S 059.87 feet; thence S 07523" E. a distance of 15.35 feet to the North line of said Puget Sound and Baker River Railway; thence Westery along the North line of said railway a distance of 17.33 feet to the point of this description.
