The United States Department of Health and Human Services, through its component Administration for Children and Families ("HHS") has awarded funds to Skagit Valley College, Skagit/Islands Head Start program, and Skagit Valley College has used federal grant funds to acquire and/or construct and/or improve the Property. The Head Start grants and federal funding incorporated conditions that include restrictions on the use of the Property and provide for a Federal Interest in the Property.

Grant funds for the acquisition and major renovation of the property to be used as Head Start facility were awarded on February 10, 2020 in Award Number 10CH01185-01-04, Amendment 4 to The Skagit Valley College District No. 4 (SVC), 2405 East College Way, Mount Vernon, Washington, 98273-5821. The governing body of SVC received a copy of this notice prior to filing on June 9, 2020.

Legal Description: The Property to which this Notice applies is identified as that certain real estate located in the City of Burlington, County of Skagit, State of Washington at 1575 South Burlington Boulevard, parcel numbers P24044, P24047 and P24056, and more specifically described as follows:

- Federal interest in this property cannot be subordinated, diminished, nullified or released through encumbrance of the property, transfer of the property to another party or any other action the grantee takes without the responsible HHS official's written permission.
