Dear Tom & Wyndham Jackson:

We have completed our review of your application for a Department of the Army permit to construct a 3-by-53-foot ramp and 8-by-30-foot dock, secured by four, 12-inch diameter steel pipe piles, in Guemes Channel, near Anacortes, Skagit County, Washington. We have assigned your project the reference number listed above. Please cite your reference number in any correspondence with us concerning this project.

Based on the information you provided to us, we have determined that Regional General Permit (RGP) 6, Structures in Inland Marine Waters of Washington State, authorizes your proposal as depicted on the enclosed drawings dated March 3, 2020. In order for this RGP authorization to be valid, you must ensure that the work is performed in accordance with the conditions, requirements, and specifications listed in the enclosed RGP-6 Enclosure.

Please be reminded that the authorized activities may only be conducted from July 16 through February 15 in any year this permit is valid. The work authorized by this permit may not be conducted from February 16 through July 15 in any year.

In order for this RGP to be valid, you must ensure that the work is performed in accordance with the following special conditions:

- a. You shall implement and abide by the mitigation plan, Jackson Dock Project Mitigation and Monitoring Plan dated December 1, 2020. Mitigation shall be constructed before or concurrent with the work authorized by the permit.
- b. An as-built mitigation construction report and as-built drawings of the mitigation area shall be submitted upon completion of mitigation construction. This report must be submitted to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch (Corps) for review and approval and must prominently display the reference number NWS-2020-478. The year mitigation construction is completed, as determined by the Corps, represents Year 0 for mitigation monitoring.

- c. Mitigation monitoring reports shall be submitted annually for 5 years to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch (Corps) by December 31 of each monitoring year. Year 1 monitoring will occur at least one year after completion of the mitigation site(s) as determined by the Corps. All reports must prominently display the reference number NWS-2020-478.
- d. To ensure the long-term protection of the mitigation site, you shall record on the mitigation site property deed a copy of this Department of the Army permit and a description of the mitigation area identified in the final mitigation plan. These documents shall be recorded with the Registrar of Deeds or other appropriate official charged with maintaining records on real property. Proof of this recorded documentation must be submitted to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch within 60 days from the date of permit issuance
- e. Your responsibility to implement the transplanting of eelgrass plan as set forth in Special Condition "a" will not be considered fulfilled until you have demonstrated planting success/survival and have received written verification from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

f. In order to meet the requirements of the Endangered Species Act you may conduct the authorized activities from July 16 through February 15 in any year this permit is valid. You shall not conduct work authorized by this permit from February 16 through July 15 in any year this permit is valid.

General Condition 3, Deed Restriction, requires that a copy of this verification letter, permit drawings, mitigation plan is recorded with the local government within 60 days from the date of this letter. You must submit proof of the deed restriction to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) within 65 days from the date of this letter.

Please remember that a report on mitigation completion or a status report must be submitted to the Corps within 12 months from the date of this letter. We recommend that you complete and submit a Status Report for Mitigation Work Completion to meet this requirement. Also, monitoring reports of the riparian mitigation planting area are due annually for 5 years from the date the Corps accepts the as-built drawings. We recommend that you complete and submit a Mitigation Planting Monitoring Report to meet this requirement. These report templates in italicized text can be found on our webpage at www.nws.usace.army.mil, select Regulatory – Regulatory/Permits, select Forms.

This permit expires on April 20, 2022. Activities that have commenced (e.g., are under construction) or are under contract to commence in reliance upon this permit will remain authorized provided that the activity is completed within one year of the date of this permit's expiration, modification, or revocation, unless discretionary authority has been exercised on a case-by-case basis to modify, suspend, or revoke the authorization.
