The Court concludes that:

- 1. There is no disputed issue of material fact as to Mr. Hanson's claim for adverse possession. To defeat Defendant's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment and prove his claim for adverse possession, Mr. Hanson must show that he possessed the subject property in a manner which was (1) exclusive, (2) open and notorious, (3) hostile, and (4) actual and uninterrupted for the statutory period of ten years. Chaplin v. Sanders. 100 Wash.2d 853, 857-62, 676 P.2d 431 (1984). The undisputed facts do not establish that Mr. Hanson took or retained possession of the subject property in a manner that was hostile and exclusive for a period of ten years.
- 2. There is also no disputed issue of material fact as to Mr. Hanson's claim for Tenancy-in-Common. Mr. Hanson has not submitted evidence sufficient to establish his claim for tenancy-in-common.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Troy Strebe's Motion for Partial Summary judgment is granted, and Plaintiff's claims for adverse possession and tenancy-in-common are dismissed.
