
- This Status Report is binding on all my heirs and/or successors and agree to hold the County harmless from any and all claims, damages, costs or expenses that are incurred whether personal injury or property damage that are water quantity, water quality or a result of the use of this alternative source.
- Water systems with filed Status Reports will not be used as justification to create new lots. Land divisions required either drilled wells or connection to an approved public system.
- Future buyers should be aware that the drinking water source for this property is provided by rainwater catchment. Public Health considers rainwater catchment as a surface water source. This source requires continuous filtration and disinfection on all faucets to be considered sanitary. This system was engineered by NW Rain Solutions and provides 168 gallons per day plus auxiliary storage in the amount of 20,000 gallons. The final inspection and as-built documents will be completed by a qualified engineer.
- Additional water for storage must be purchased from a public water system approved by the Washington Department of Health.
- I agree to abide by the operations and monitoring requirements submitted with the water source application documents and make monitoring information available to the Health Officer upon request.

Connection to a public water system, when available, is recommended by Public Health. I have read and fully understand the conditions contained within this notification.


