For and in consideration of an agreement between the parties, and for no monetary consideration, Grantor hereby grants and conveys to Grantees a non-exclusive easement for a utility line over and across the property described and as set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

The easement herein granted shall be further conditioned on and governed by the following covenant running with the land:

That if the Grantees or their agents, successors or assigns perform or cause to be performed any maintenance, alterations, construction, or other activities in, on or under the subject easement area, that the Grantees (or their agents, successors or assigns, as the case may be) shall promptly restore the said property to its condition as the same existed immediately prior thereto, at their sole cost and expense, and that Grantees (or their agents, successors or assigns, as the case may be) shall further indemnify and hold Grantor harmless from any costs, liabilities or obligations resulting therefrom or incident thereto.
