II.

No action commenced by the Beneficiary of the Deed of Trust is now pending to seek satisfaction of the obligation in any Court by reason of the Borrower's or Grantor's default on the obligation secured by the Deed of Trust.

Delinquent monthly payments from the June 1, 2020 installment on in the sum of \$16,134.18 together with all fees, costs and or disbursements incurred or paid by the beneficiary and or trustee, their employees, agents or assigns. The Trustee's fees and costs are estimated at \$2,633.58 as of September 6, 2022. The amount to cure the default payments as of the date of this notice is \$18,767.76. Payments and late charges may continue to accrue and additional advances to your loan may be made. It is necessary to contact the beneficiary or Trustee prior to the time you tender the reinstatement amount so that you may be advised of the exact amount you would be required to pay.

NOTICE TO OCCUPANTS OR TENANTS
