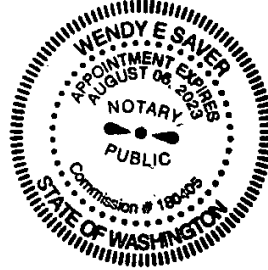

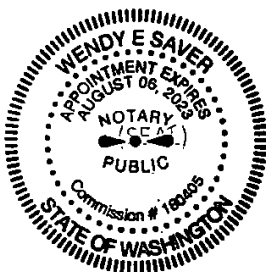

5. Type or clearly print in the box on Exhibit A the full legal description of the property.
6. Prior to recording, bring the covenant to PCED for review by the planner associated with your project.
7. Bring the reviewed covenant to Skagit Count for recording and return a copy of the recorded document with recording number stamp to PCED to receive your permit.
