Waiver of 200' Foot Setbacks for Properties Outside of and Immediately Adjacent to **Designated Natural Resource Lands**

Notice: This parcel lies outside of and immediately adjacent to an area designated as a Natural Resource Land (agricultural, forest or mineral resource lands of long-term commercial significance) in Skagit County. Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.16.810(7) such parcels shall observe a minimum 200' building setback from such Natural Resource Lands unless a waiver is obtained. The property owner hereby waives the 200 foot setback by acknowledging in this title notification the possible occurrence of agriculture, forestry or mining activity on the adjacent property. The property owner identified herein also waives for all current and future owners, any claim for damages that may occur to the building or occupants because of activities which are conducted in accordance with applicable state regulations. The property owner thus acknowledges that a variety of Natural Resource Land commercial activities occur or may occur in the area that may not be compatible with non-resource uses and may be inconvenient or cause discomfort to area residents. This may arise from the use of chemicals; or from spraying, pruning, harvesting, or mineral extraction with associated activities, which occasionally generates traffic, dust, smoke, noise, and odor. Skagit County has established natural resource management operations as a priority use on designated Natural Resource Lands, and area residents should be prepared to accept such incompatibilities, inconveniences or discomfort from normal, necessary Natural Resource Land operations when performed in compliance with Best Management Practices and local, State, and Federal law." In the case of mineral lands, application might be made for mining-related activities including extraction, washing, crushing, stockpiling, blasting, transporting and recycling of minerals.
