

From CHA to COVID Recovery Plan



- Promotores and Community Health Workers
- SVC Leadership development programs
- Collaboration across organizations/programs to increase awareness

- Disparities in social determinants of health
- Lack of cultural awareness and knowledge about issues of equity, inclusion and impacts of systemic racism
 Efforts to bring marginalized populations into the conversation

- Increasing resources (Homes funds, 1406, 1590)
- Collaborative approaches at multiple levels of government

- Funding for predevelopment, flexible funding, long-term project services and operating funds
- To affordably rent a 2bedroom apt., a Skagit County household would need to make \$51,080/year





- Expansion of in-school support for school-age youth
- Prevention efforts
- Collaboration with Law Enforcement – SCSO IMPACT program, LEAD

Behavioral Health

- Workforce shortages
- Low wage jobs in highly stressful environment
- Lack of knowledge of specific cultural needs and challenges of populations
- Complexity of system

- Collaborations resulting from HB1310 Compass Health/law enforcement program

- Equitable access to technology and consistent, reliable broadband
- Access to providers who know language and culture of patients
- Staffing crises
