The Skagit County Board of Health met in regular session on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, with Chair Peter Browning, Commissioner Lisa Janicki, and Commissioner Ron Wesen present.

- b) Public Health Director Remarks

Public Health Director Keith Higman discussed the primary functions of the Board of Health and developing policy around On-Site Sewage Code revisions.

c) Presentation on SCC 12.05 OSS Code Revisions, Q & A

Environmental Health Specialist Charese Gainor provided a PowerPoint presentation. She said that on-site regulations start with the Washington State Department of Health (WADOH) and that Washington Administrative Code Chapter 246-272A was the basis for all septic systems in Washington state. WADOH began the rule revision process in 2018 and adoption occurred on January 10, 2024. She noted that the WADOH adoption set in motion that all local health jurisdictions needed to review local regulations and she reviewed the timeline.

Ms. Gainor shared that proposed revisions included permitting software, adoption of current practices, clarification and definitions, new requirements, and additional detail. She reviewed operational permits, highest seasonal water table data, the difference between a variance and waiver, proposed new requirements, soil evaluation test pits, and homeowner installation education.

Environmental Health Manager Britt Pfaff-Dunton shared that next steps included a public comment period, review of public comments received, public hearing, followed by possible action to adopt.
