

Skagit County Volunteer Activity Parental Permission and Release for Minors

I am fully aware of the fact that there are common and special dangers and risks inherent in this Volunteer activity, including, but not limited to, the risk of personal and physical injury, which may range from minor cuts and strains to death or other harmful consequences that may arise or result directly or indirectly from the minor's participation in this activity.
Being competent and fully informed as to these risks and in consideration of the minor being allowed to participate, I hereby assume all risk of personal and physical injury, damage, death or harmful consequences to the minor arising from his/her participation in the activity described above, including unintentional injury arising from first aid and emergent medical care. I also hereby individually and on behalf of the minor's heirs, executors and assigns, release and hold harmless Skagit County and its officials, employees, instructors, volunteers and agents and waive any right of recovery that I or the minor might have to bring a claim or a lawsuit against them for any personal and physical injury, death or other harmful consequence occurring to the minor and arising out of his/her voluntary participation in the activity.
I further acknowledge that should the minor be injured while performing volunteer activities, I am required to immediately or at the first reasonable opportunity report the injury to Skagit County Risk Management, which may arrange for payment of medical costs as allowed under the state workers' compensation laws.
