#### b) ASSIGNED COUNSEL:

2. Personal Services Agreement with Eli Wainman, Attorney at Law, to provide consultation and representation for cases that are considered to be conflict of interest cases for the Skagit County Public Defender's office and have been determined to be within the scope of indigent defense. Case referrals will be from Superior Court, Juvenile Court, and District Court. Total compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$165,000 for the term of the Agreement. The Agreement shall commence on February 1, 2021, and continue until December 31, 2022.

#### c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

3. Vendor Services Agreement with Cascade Roofing Company, Inc. to supply all labor, demolition, materials, and equipment for the removal of damaged roofing materials from all of the Transfer Station Vactor Waste Roofs and grounds around the facility located at 14158 Ovenell Road in Mount Vernon. Compensation shall not exceed \$6,672.75 which includes applicable tax. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 20, 2021, and continue for one (1) month from the date of execution.

#### d) <u>PUBLIC HEALTH:</u>

- 4. Personal Services Agreement with The Language Exchange, Inc. to provide interpretation and translation services. Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$15,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2021, and continue until December 31, 2021.
- 5. Resolution to approve the submission of the 2019-2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Services contract closeout report and designate Trisha Logue as Chief Administrative Official and the authorized representative to act in all official matters in connection with this closeout report.
- 6. Resolution declaring a continued public health emergency and modified purchasing, bidding, and public notice requirements regarding food provision for those housed at the COVID-19 isolation and quarantine site.
- 7. Amendment No. 4 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20200340 with Rancho Alegre to provide additional food services for guests staying in isolation/quarantine at 866 Burlington Boulevard in Burlington and other motel locations as requested by Skagit County. This Amendment increases compensation by \$60,000 due to the increased community need related to a rise in COVID-19 cases. Total compensation shall not exceed \$80,000. This Amendment also extends the term of the Agreement from January 31, 2021, to June 30, 2021. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
- 8. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Washington State University (WSU) to provide Skagit County families with the Strengthening Families Program (SFP) for 10-14 year olds. Compensation is based on a cost reimbursement rate and shall not exceed \$17,500, inclusive of 26% administration rate. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2021.
