## a) **COMMISSIONERS**:

### b) INFORMATION SERVICES:

4. Personal Services Agreement with Dimensional Communications, Inc. to provide hardware, software, support, and to maintain services to equipment in Skagit County's courtrooms, Community Justice Center, and Skagit 21 production studio. Compensation shall not exceed \$80,000 and is based on a maintenance fee schedule. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2020.

## c) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 5. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Burlington to provide funding support to Skagit County for the Senior Services program operated in Burlington. Compensation shall not exceed \$13,131. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2020 and shall continue until December 31, 2020.
- 6. Event Contract with Swinomish Casino & Lodge to provide conference meeting facilities and equipment as well as food and beverage service for the Pregnancy and Opioid Use Disorder Conference on April 29, 2020. Compensation shall not exceed 12,315.70.
- 7. Personal Services Agreement with Welcome Home Skagit to manage and operate a temporary low-barrier shelter at the Mount Baker Presbyterian Church in Concrete. Compensation is based on a fee schedule, shall not exceed \$100,000, and is funded by the 1/10<sup>th</sup> of 1% chemical dependency or mental health treatment sales tax. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until March 31, 2020.

# d) SHERIFF:

- 8. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Sedro-Woolley to establish the procedures and responsibilities of the Skagit County Sheriff's Office and the Sedro-Woolley Police Department for the reimbursement of overtime costs to the City, and other expenses and duties. Compensation shall not exceed \$15,000 per calendar year. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and remain in effect until terminated.
- 9. Vendor Services Agreement with R & R Kennel & Storage to provide services related to boarding the Sheriff's K-9 dogs on an as-needed basis. Compensation shall not exceed \$ 2,500 per calendar year and is based on a fee schedule. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2024.
- 10. Amendment No. 1 to Interlocal Agreement No. C20190635 with the Town of Concrete for law enforcement services. This Amendment adds to Section 4.3 "Periodic Reports" the provision of a quarterly report on deputy time in the 10 minute response area as defined in Exhibit A. Compensation remains at an amount not to exceed \$900,645. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2022. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

### e) SUPERIOR COURT:

11. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20190637 with The Language Exchange, Inc. to provide interpretation and translation services for Superior and District Court. This Amendment adds GL Code 001 52200064110 to the professional services expenses. Compensation remains at an amount not to exceed \$150,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect including the termination date of December 31, 2020.

## f) TREASURER:

12. Agreement with LexisNexis for a subscription to Accurint for Government to provide access to searches and reports for county business. Compensation shall be \$100 per month plus any additional fees that are outlined in Schedule A that may occur in a given month when the cap of \$150 is exceeded. The Agreement is ratified to commence on December 1, 2019 and shall continue until terminated.
