a) COMMISSIONERS:

- 3. Resolution calling for bids for County legal printing for 2017 through 2018. The bid opening is scheduled to take place on Monday, March 20, 2017, at 2:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible in the Skagit County Commissioners' Hearing Room.

b) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

- 4. Personal Services Agreement with Carletti Architects, P.S. to provide research, construction documents, technical specifications, and construction administration for a roof replacement project on the existing Skagit County Juvenile Detention Center located at 605 South Third Street in Mount Vernon. Compensation shall not exceed \$45,000 and is based on a fee schedule. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until January 31, 2018.
- 5. Personal Services Agreement with Pacific MicroRem, Inc. for a close-end equipment lease to provide the Smiths Detection 6040i X-ray imaging system, or comparable equipment, delivering an X-ray imaging capability for baggage and other small items at security checkpoints in Skagit County buildings as directed by the Facilities Management Department. The machines will be located at two Skagit County buildings and potentially the new County jail. The County shall pay \$500 per month per leased system plus applicable sales tax for the duration of the contract. In addition, the County shall pay a one-time fee of \$1,000 for delivery and installation of each system which includes training of operators and removal of the equipment at the conclusion of the contract. Total compensation for the duration of the contract shall not exceed \$60,000. The Agreement is being ratified to commence on January 23, 2017, and continues until January 31, 2020.

c) INFORMATION SERVICES:

6. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Skagit Council of Governments (SCOG) to provide technology support services. Charges for products and services provided by the County will be based on actual costs incurred by the County. The Agreement is being ratified to commence on January 1, 2017, and continue until December 31, 2019.

d) OFFICE OF JUVENILE COURT:

7. Resolution amending Resolution No. R20120377 and revising the assessment and collection of diversion fees from \$80 to \$100 per diversion case, effective March 1, 2017, the Skagit County Office of Juvenile Court will assess the fee to offset the costs of the diversion program.

e) PUBLIC HEALTH:

8. Funding Agreement with the Samish Indian Nation to distribute low-income funds pursuant to Substitute House Bill 2163. Funding will reimburse the Samish Indian Nation for personnel, negotiated indirect costs, office supplies, and rental and emergency financial assistance to support clients of the homelessness diversion pilot program. Compensation shall not exceed \$30,000. The Agreement is being ratified to commence on January 1, 2017, and continues until June 30, 2017.

f) PUBLIC WORKS:

- 9. Resolution awarding bids for rental equipment to the following eight (8) vendors: Birch Equipment Rental, Herc Rentals, Inc., NW Relining, LLC, Pape Machinery, Inc., Powerscreen of Washington, United Rentals (North America), Inc., Van's Equipment Co., and Xylem Dewatering Solutions, Inc., for anticipated annual usage in excess of \$25,000 for each vendor annually.
- 10. Resolution to award the bid for one (1) new latest model variable width hydrostatically driven chip spreader to PacWest Machinery, LLC for \$242,991.17 which includes the trade-in value of \$35,000 for the existing chip spreader. This unit will replace an existing chip spreader in the road operation division fleet.

- 11. Resolution to call for bids for landscaping maintenance at two (2) Guemes Island Ferry County-owned parking lots located near the Guemes Island Ferry terminal on 500 I Avenue in Anacortes; Skagit County road operations facility located at 201 East Avon Avenue in Burlington; Conway Roundabout located at the intersection of Pioneer Highway and Fir Island Road in Conway; South LaVenture Road, maintenance of the planting strip between Blackburn Road and Blodgett Road in Mount Vernon; and the transfer station located at 14104 Ovenell Road in Mount Vernon. - 12. Resolution to request qualifications for naval architecture and marine engineering services for the Skagit County Guemes Ferry Replacement Project #ESMVGUEMES.
- 13. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20140054 with Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group to assist Skagit County in the continuation of the Natural Resource Stewardship Program (NRSP). This Amendment reflects the recent grant extension awarded to Skagit County from the Department of Ecology as well as an additional grant from the Washington State Conservation Commission which amounts to an additional \$40,000. The new compensation amount shall not exceed \$340,000 and is 87.5% funded through the NRSP grant. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect including the termination date of December 31, 2017.
