COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE:

- 1. Record of the Proceedings for Monday, February 23, 2004.
- 2. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between Skagit County and the Skagit Conservation District for the coordination of the development, implementation and maintenance of water quality programs. The agreement shall commence on January 1, 2004 and continue through December 31, 2004. Compensation shall total \$7,291.67 per month, not-to-exceed the amount of \$87,500.
- 3. Resolution calling for bids for County legal printing for 2004-2005. The bid opening will be held on Monday, April 5, 2004 at 10:45 a.m.
- 4. Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Agreement <u>No. 005220</u> with the City of Sedro-Woolley for Public Facility Project Funding, which extends the agreement to February 27, 2005. All other terms and conditions shall remain in effect.

FARMLAND LEGACY PROGRAM:

6. Vendor Services Agreement with Skagit Land Trust, to provide assistance to the County in fulfilling the terms of a Salmon Recovery Funding Board grant to permanently protect 474 acres of strategic habitat and farmland on Hart Island in the Sedro-Woolley area. The agreement shall commence on March 10, 2004 and continue until October 10, 2004. Compensation is not to exceed a maximum total of \$15,000.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

- 7. Amendment No. 8 to the State Department of Health Consolidated Contract <u>No. C20020436</u>, which increases compensation by an additional \$45,000 for a revised total maximum consideration of \$1,149,342. This funding is added to the Bio-terrorism/Focus B Program for the period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004.

- 14. Personal Services Agreement with Mary Dumas to facilitate an ARIS staff retreat on February 19, 2004, including additional follow-up meetings. The agreement shall commence on February 15, 2004 and continue until December 12, 2004. Compensation is not to exceed a total of \$5,000.
- 15. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between Skagit County and the Anacortes School District, to provide Mental Health Services. The agreement shall commence on January 1, 2004 and continue through December 31, 2004. Compensation to the County shall total \$8,000.
- 16. Personal Services Agreement with the Skagit Valley Family YMCA, to provide services to youth of low income families referred by the At Risk Intervention Specialist (ARIS) program. The agreement shall commence on March 1, 2004 and continue until December 31, 2005. Compensation is not to exceed a total of \$5,000.

Resolution **AND** Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between Skagit County and the City of Sedro-Woolley, which allows the City to contribute \$25,000 from their annual budget in support of the Skagit River Feasibility Study. The agreement shall commence on January 1, 2004 and continue through December 31, 2004.
- 26. Vendor Services Agreement with GeoTest Services, Inc., to provide testing for the McTaggart Avenue Asphalt Overlay Project, No. ES20020-3. The agreement shall commence on March 1, 2004 and continue through February 28, 2005. Compensation is not to exceed a total of \$5,000.
