9. Agreement with Economic Development Alliance of Skagit County (EDASC), Contract # 44800-1371-22, to award \$47,000 for administrative and marketing services for Skagit County. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2022 and shall continue until December 31, 2022.

c) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVCIES:

10. Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Agreement No. C20180481 with the Cities of Anacortes, Burlington, Mount Vernon, and Sedro-Woolley for the provision of emergency medical services through Skagit County. This Amendment updates "Exhibit B" regarding Compensation for replacement of Medical Program Director-approved video laryngoscopes and provides reimbursement for these devices in the amount of \$57,600. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2024. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect.

d) <u>PUBLIC HEALTH:</u>

- 11. Agreement with Cascade Radio Group for the provision of radio announcements regarding COVID-19 vaccine and testing information. Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$26,400. The Agreement is ratified to commence on April 1, 2022 and shall continue through June 30, 2022.
- 12. Agreement (Contract #MRC 22-1027) with the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) to provide grant funding to Skagit County to build the capacity of the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) unit. Funding to Skagit County shall not exceed \$5,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until September 29, 2022.

e) PUBLIC WORKS:

- 13. Resolution awarding the bid for Electrical Maintenance and Repair Services for the Guemes Island Ferry, Solid Waste and Operations Division to VECA Electric and Technologies, LLC in the amount of \$120 per hour and a total contract amount not to exceed \$250,000.
- 14. Resolution authorizing the removal of approximately 12 trees within County right-of-way on Concrete Road (County Road #96600) in the vicinity of and adjacent to parcel number P70966. Applicant is clearing adjacent land and is concerned that trees will become dangerous now that they will be exposed to increased wind speeds.
- 15. Vendor Services Agreement with Culbertson Marine Construction, Inc. for the Emergency Repair of the Anacortes Breakwater at the Anacortes Ferry Terminal for the Guemes Island Ferry pursuant to Resolution No. R20210248. Compensation shall not exceed \$176,386.12. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2022 and continue for one year.
- 16. Vendor Services Agreement with Dakota Creek Industries, Inc. for the Emergency Repair of the bilge pump piping on the M/V Guemes Ferry pursuant to Resolution No. R20220049. Compensation shall not exceed \$2,339.02. The Agreement is ratified to commence on February 8, 2022 and shall continue for one year.
