The Application/Permit to Cut or Remove Trees on County Right-of-Way was submitted by Puget Sound Energy.
- 8. Amendment No. 1 to Grant Deed of Conservation Easement, Contract No. C20040027, protecting farmland owned by Jean and Sidney DeBoer. This easement extinguished all development rights and approximately 46.4 acres as part of a two-lot Short Plat #PL03-0729 located north of the City of Burlington at 20913 Kelleher Road. This Amendment and Release of Grant Deed corrects the legal description of the original Grant Deed to remove the easement encumbrance from Parcel No. P36103. This Amendment will not diminish the purpose of the original easement, which protects 46.4 acres of agricultural land in perpetuity.

e) <u>SHERIFF:</u>

9. Amendment No. 4 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20170464 with Txley Corporation to provide chemicals for laundry and general cleaning at the Skagit County Community Justice Center. This Amendment increases compensation from \$20,000 per calendar year to an amount not to exceed \$25,000 per calendar year to cover additional supplies and services. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect. This Agreement continues until terminated.
