COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE:

- 3. Resolution establishing a new per diem rate for the Board of Equalization members. The rate is increased from \$125 per day to \$150 per day, effective May 1, 2005.

BUDGET AND FINANCE:

- 4. Amendment No. 4 to Agreement <u>No. C20030199</u> between Skagit County and Aero-Skagit Emergency Medical Services, Inc. authorizing supplemental funding in the amount of \$129,564 for 2005, for a new contract total of \$370,631. It also recognizes that the contractor serves a rural area where responses can't always happen in 20 minutes.
- 5. Amendment No. 1 to Interlocal Cooperative Agreement **No. C20040465** between Skagit County and the Town of Hamilton. Skagit County is acting a fiscal agent on behalf of the Town. This amendment adds fiscal agency responsibilities for an additional FCAAP grant and allows for future expansion of the County's role as new grants may be awarded. The County has the right to decline to serve as fiscal agent for any additional grants.
