Compensation shall not exceed \$66,111.24 plus applicable tax. The Agreement is ratified to commence on May 1, 2020, and shall continue until April 30, 2022.

d) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 7. Resolution calling for a public hearing to consider an application for the Community Development Block Grant Public Service Grant Program on Wednesday, May 20, 2020, at 11:30 a.m. or as soon as possible thereafter. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20200127 with John Bowey dba Transmediavision to assist Skagit County Public Health in conveying critical and time sensitive messaging to the public at large regarding COVID-19. This Amendment increases compensation by \$40,000 for additional messaging to the public about issues and concerns. Total compensation shall not exceed \$75,000. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2020. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 9. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20190458 with Skagit Preschool and Resource Center (SPARC) to provide early intervention services for eligible infants and toddlers with developmental delays and their families living in Skagit County. This Amendment increases the amount per child/per month billing rate. Compensation remains the same and shall not exceed \$78,414 and is funded by Developmental Disabilities Administration Professional Services Funding. The term remains the same and shall continue until June 30, 2020. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 10. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20200128 with Community Action of Skagit County for the provision of motel vouchers for homeless households that include an individual at the highest risk of complications from COVID-19. This Amendment replaces Exhibit "B" Scope of Work in its entirety and increases compensation by \$170,000. Total compensation shall not exceed \$200,000. The term remains the same and shall continue until May 31, 2020. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
