d) OFFICE OF JUVENILE COURT:

Personal Services Agreement with Youthnet to provide intake to determine goals and develop an individualized independent living skills plan for youth referred by the Skagit County Office of Juvenile Court and accepted by Youthnet. Compensation shall not exceed \$6,000 annually for a total of \$12,000. The Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2021, and continue until June 30, 2023.

e) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 9. Resolution approving the submission of a grant application to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for community health workers for COVID response and resilient communities, and designating Bob Hicks, Public Health Assistant Director, as the authorized representative to act in all official matters in connection with this grant application.
- 10. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Northwest Educational Service District 189 to provide assessment and planning related to the expansion of pre-k to grade 12 school-based behavioral health services in Skagit County in response to impacts resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. Compensation shall not exceed \$120,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2021.
- 11. Advertiser Agreement with Outfront Media for two (2) billboard advertisements to promote Skagit County Public Health's vaccine clinic at the Skagit County Fairgrounds. Compensation shall not exceed \$1,700. The Agreement shall commence on June 21, 2021, and continue until July 25, 2021.
- 12. Advertising Non-Space Agreement with Outfront Media for production, installation, and advertising services to promote Skagit County Public Health's vaccine clinic at the Skagit County Fairgrounds. Compensation shall not exceed \$1,950. The Agreement shall commence on June 21, 2021 and continue until July 25, 2021.
- 13. Inspection Services Agreement with Shelter Bay Community Inc. to provide temporary inspection services related to Shelter Bay's community pool facility. Shelter Bay Community, Inc. shall reimburse the County at the rate of \$95.00 per hour. The Agreement is ratified to commence on April 30, 2021, and continue until July 31, 2021.
- 14. Amendment No. 1 to Interlocal Cooperative Agreement No. C20210043 with Skagit Valley College to prepare and provide meals as ordered by the County, and deliver them to a county-identified site or sites. This Amendment increases compensation by \$10,050, to an amount not to exceed \$35,000. All other terms and
