c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

Amendment No. 2 to Agreement with Northwest Regional Council (NWRC), Northwest Washington Area Agency on Aging, NWRC Contract No. 205018-NUTR, (Skagit County Agreement No. C20210064), to provide congregate and home-delivered meals through Senior Nutrition Services. This Amendment increases compensation by \$7,899 to provide additional one time funds for Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program vouchers. Total compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$360,343. The Amendment is ratified to commence on June 1, 2021. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect including the term which ends on December 31, 2021.
- 11. Personal Services Agreement with Sunny Ledge Enterprises dba Avenue Catering to provide daily meal service to those in quarantine and isolation as identified by the Public Health Department. Compensation shall not exceed \$60,000. The Agreement shall commence on June 16, 2021 and continue until December 31, 2021.
- 12. Personal Services Agreement with Lifeline Connections to provide case management and recovery support services to individuals enrolled in the Skagit County Adult Felony Drug Court.
