### b) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES:

- 4. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the Concrete Fire Department (Department) to allow the Department and the County to work in cooperation on the delivery of emergency medical services (EMS) within the Department's boundaries, as well as outside its boundaries as allowed by mutual aid requests. Skagit County shall reimburse the Department for actual expenses incurred in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 for the entire term of the Agreement. This Agreement replaces and supersedes Skagit County Contract No. C20190046, is ratified to commence on May 14, 2019, and continue until December 31, 2024.
- 5. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Fire District 19 (District) to allow the District and the County to work in cooperation on the delivery of emergency medical services (EMS) within the District's boundaries, as well as outside its boundaries as allowed by mutual aid requests. Skagit County shall reimburse the District for actual expenses incurred in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 for the entire term of the Agreement. This Agreement replaces and supersedes Skagit County Contract No. C20180691, is ratified to commence on May 14, 2019, and continue until December 31, 2024.
- 6. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Fire District 17 (District) to allow the District and the County to work in cooperation on the delivery of emergency medical services (EMS) within the District's boundaries, as well as outside its boundaries as allowed by mutual aid requests. Skagit County shall reimburse the District for actual expenses incurred in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 for the entire term of the Agreement. This Agreement replaces and supersedes Skagit County Contract No. C20180690, is ratified to commence on May 14, 2019, and continue until December 31, 2024.

# c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

7. Personal Services Agreement with Carletti Architect, P.S. for planning and development services to facilitate permitting, design, and construction of the Skagit County Evaluation and Treatment Center. Compensation shall not exceed \$225,792 excluding pre-agreed upon reimbursable items. The Agreement is ratified to commence on May 1, 2019, and shall continue until December 31, 2021.

## d) PARKS, RECREATION AND FAIR:

8. Personal Services Agreement with Graham-Bunting & Associates to provide wetland related regulatory services and critical area site assessment for P25048 and P25050 for use as athletic fields and associated facilities. Compensation shall not exceed \$9,800 and is based on an hourly fee schedule. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2019.

## e) PROSECUTING ATTORNEY:

9. Personal Services Agreement with DriveSavers, Inc. to provide expert witness services and testimony in the case State v. Ernesto Rivas, Skagit County Superior Court Cause No. 16-1-01284-1. Compensation shall not exceed \$10,000 and is based on an hourly fee schedule. The Agreement is ratified to commence on June 25, 2019, and shall continue until December 31, 2019.

# f) PUBLIC HEALTH:

10. Personal Services Agreement with Pioneer Human Services for the provision of clinically managed, sub-acute, withdrawal management services from psychoactive substances to Skagit County residents that are 18 years or older and do not have medical insurance. Compensation shall not exceed \$61,124.98. The Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2019, and continue until December 31, 2019.

### g) PUBLIC WORKS:

11. Amendment No. 2 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20170208 with Pacific Northwest Scale Company, Inc. to provide scale calibration, maintenance and repair at the Transfer and Recycling Station located at 14158 Ovenell Road in Mount Vernon, and at the Transfer Station located at 50796 Sauk Landfill Road in Concrete. This Amendment increases compensation by \$1,500 for additional repairs that needed to be performed. Total

- Compensation shall not exceed \$28,500 and is based on a fee schedule. This Amendment is ratified to commence on June 1, 2019, and shall continue through July 31, 2019. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and subsequent Amendment shall remain in effect.
- 12. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20170193 with Edge Analytical Laboratories to analyze water, soil, sediment, and/or sludge samples submitted by the County as directed on the chain-of-custody document and in accordance with standard test methods appropriate to meet the project objectives. The work is a requirement of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. These services will be utilized by several departments including Public Works and Planning and Development Services. This Amendment is ratified to commence on June 1, 2019, and shall extend the term of the Agreement through May 31, 2020. Exhibit B, Compensation, is also revised to include an additional pricing schedule. Total compensation remains the same and shall not exceed \$475,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 13. Personal Services Agreement with PND Engineers, Inc. for the provision of emergency inspections of the Anacortes wingwall piling repairs which was authorized by Resolution No. R20190108. Compensation shall not exceed \$2,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on June 17, 2019, and shall continue until December 31, 2019.

# h) SHERIFF:
