c) HUMAN RESOURCES:

6. Memorandum of Agreement (Amendment No. 1) to Labor Agreement No. C20250521 with Skagit County Public Defender's Support Staff Local 176 PDS, Council #2, AFSCME. This Amendment extends the County's Voluntary Furlough Program to Public Defender Support Staff members. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

d) OFFICE OF JUVENILE COURT:

7. Interagency Agreement with the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC No. AOC3405) to increase the number of children served by court-appointed special advocates (CASAs)/volunteer guardians ad litem as defined by RCW 13.34.030(12) in dependency matters or to reduce the average caseload of volunteers to recommended standards. Reimbursement to Skagit County shall not exceed \$64,387. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2026 and continue until June 30, 2027.

e) PARKS, RECREATION AND FAIR:

8. Resolution to authorize Skagit County to submit an application to seek grant funding assistance through the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) for RCO Project Number 26-1363 for the Nookachamps/Centennial Trail Development Project.
9. Resolution to call for a public hearing to consider testimony regarding the sale and disposition of Skagit County Real Property located at 59968 State Route 20 in Marblemount (Parcel No. P45245). The public hearing is scheduled to take place on Monday, August 3, 2026, at 1:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible in the Skagit County Commissioners Hearing Room located at 1800 Continental in Mount Vernon. 10. Vendor Services Agreement with Paradise Amusements, Inc. to provide, manage and maintain a carnival consisting of rides and gaming booths at the Skagit County Fairgrounds. Skagit County will be compensated 25% of ticket and wristband sales. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for one year.
11. Vendor Services Agreement with Pacific Party Canopies, Inc. to provide the installation and take-down of tents, stages, tables, chairs, and umbrellas for the 2026 Skagit County Fair. Compensation shall not exceed \$20,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for one year.
12. Personal Services Agreement with FUSION Talent Group, Inc. to provide a mobile entertainment stage and perform three stage show sets, a minimum of 30 minutes each, each day of the 2026 Skagit County Fair. Compensation shall not exceed \$14,000 and is based on a rate schedule. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2026.

f) PUBLIC HEALTH:

13. Professional Services Contract with Washington State Health Care Authority, HCA Contract Number K9055, for Recovery Support Services. Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$176,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2026 and continue through June 30, 2027.
14. Personal Services Agreement with Skagit Valley YMCA to operate the Oasis Youth Shelter, seven days per week, every day of the year. Compensation shall not exceed \$65,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2026 and continue until June 30, 2027.

15. Personal Services Agreement with Family Promise of Skagit Valley to provide year-round shelter and transitional housing services for families with children. Compensation shall not exceed \$245,941. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2026 and shall continue until June 30, 2027.

g) PUBLIC WORKS:

16. Vendor Services Agreement with Valley Fence to install six gate holdbacks on chain link fence gates for the truck haul, recycle, and main entrance routes into the Skagit County Transfer Station located at 14104 Ovenell Road in Mount Vernon, and install two gate holdbacks on the chain link fence gates for the front entrance into the Clear Lake Compactor Site located at 23202 Howey Road in Clear Lake. Compensation shall not exceed \$3,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for two years.

h) SHERIFF:

17. Agreement with Public Safety Testing, Inc. for promotional testing services for the Patrol Sergeant, Corrections Sergeant, Patrol Lieutenant, and Corrections Lieutenant including Command Skills and Abilities testing. Compensation shall not exceed \$40,600 and is based on a rate schedule. The Agreement is ratified to commence on June 11, 2026 and shall continue for one year.

i) SUPERIOR COURT:

18. Personal Services Agreement with INTERCOM Language Services to provide court-certified, court-registered, interpreter services for Superior Court hearings. Compensation shall not exceed \$30,000 per year and is based on a rate schedule. The Agreement is ratified to commence on June 15, 2026 and shall continue until December 31, 2027.

a) PUBLIC WORKS:

1. Amendment No. 1 to Skagit County Farmland Legacy Program (FLP) Deed of Conservation Easement No. C20250132 with Gerald E. Nelson and Jenny T. Nelson to protect 40 acres of agricultural land on Parcel No. P34659. This Amendment adds 41.1 acres of protected agricultural land to the original easement area for a total of 81.1 acres to reflect a recent Boundary Line Adjustment. No compensation is associated with this Amendment. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
