Compensation is based on a rates schedule and shall not exceed \$142,267.37. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for one (1) year.

3. Farmland Legacy Program Grant Deed of Conservation Easement with Michael Tobiason and Wendell Tobiason, executors of the Estate of Gertrud Tobiason, deceased, to place a Conservation Easement to protect 103 acres of agricultural land on Parcel Numbers P16458, P16468, P16471, and P16475 and eliminates two (2) residential development rights. Compensation shall not exceed \$155,000. The Conservation Values include protection of agricultural productivity and the protection of prime and important agricultural soils. The Agreement shall commence on mutual execution and continue in perpetuity.

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- 4. Statutory Warranty Deed from Apex Farms, Inc. (Grantor) to grant a portion of Parcel Number P34973 to Skagit County (Grantee) to be used as public road right-of-way for the Farm to Market/Josh Wilson Intersection Improvements Project #ES31010-4.
