Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$14,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2022 and shall continue through June 30, 2023.
- 7. Personal Services Agreement with Helping Hands Project Organization to administer the Eviction Rental Assistance Program 2.0 (ERAP 2.0) Grant to prevent evictions by providing outreach services and application preparation and review for marginalized communities in order to increase access to ERAP 2.0. Compensation shall not exceed \$112,320. The Agreement is ratified to commence on August 1, 2022 and continue until December 31, 2022.
- 8. Interlocal Agreement with Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) to support the development of a community-based structure for providing direct services to support parents and families experiencing Perinatal Mood and Anxiety Disorders (PMADs). Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$22,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2022 and continue until July 15, 2023.
- 9. Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. C2O220070 with Galaxy Digital to provide volunteer management software. This Amendment updates the pricing table and includes the addition of Exhibit "E", Data Sharing Agreement to provide an additional license for Skagit County Public Health. Compensation is increased from \$12,000 to an amount not to exceed \$24,500. The term remains unchanged and will continue until December 31, 2023. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

e) PUBLIC WORKS:

- 10. Construction Contract Agreement with Specialized Pavement Marking, LLC for the Prairie Road Guidance Improvements Project #ES50000-7; Federal Aid #HSIP-T292(002). Compensation shall not exceed \$127,716.75. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until completion.

Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$40,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on August 1, 2022 and continue until August 1, 2023.
- 12. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Burlington for the County to provide reimbursable services on behalf of the City regarding the development and implementation of a stormwater source control program intended to satisfy the requirements of the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Western Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit. Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$40,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on August 1, 2022 and continue until August 1, 2023.
- 13. Amendment No. 3 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20190407 with Bronlea M Consulting, LLC to provide communications services for the Skagit County Public Works Ferry Division in the form of newsletters and other public outreach materials. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement by one additional year, ending September 16, 2023. Compensation remains at an amount not to exceed \$15,000. Amendment No. 2 to Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces (OCDETF) Investigation/Strategic Initiative Number PA-WAW-0362, Skagit County Contract No. Contract No. C20220034 for fiscal year 2022, for the purpose of receiving reimbursement for costs incurred by the Skagit County Sheriff's Office in providing resources to joint operations/task forces. This Amendment increases compensation to Skagit County by \$5,000 for a new total compensation amount not to exceed \$12,840.The term remains unchanged and shall continue until September 30, 2022. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect.
