## b) <u>COMMUNITY SERVICES:</u>

4. Amendment No. 1 to Interagency Agreement No. C20150044 with North Sound Mental Health Administration (NSMHA) #NSMHA-SKAGIT-ADMIN-15 to provide funding for county staff to participate in regional (NSMHA) related administrative functions in Skagit County and to provide funding for housing vouchers and supports. This Amendment adds a new section to B.7 regarding the provision of a peer run recovery center, and, increases compensation to Skagit County for funding of the center by \$37,500. Total compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$294,072. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

## c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

5. Personal Services Agreement with Howard Consulting, LLC to provide contractor services as Construction Administrator/Owner's Site Representative on the Skagit County Jail Project and to assist the Facilities Management Department with Capital Project Management Services. The Agreement shall commence on September 1, 2015, and continue until December 31, 2017. Compensation shall not exceed \$201,000.

### d) **PUBLIC DEFENDER:**

Personal Services Agreement with Dennis Scott to provide consultation and representation relating to clients on behalf of the Skagit County Public Defender for mental health and involuntary commitment hearings in conjunction with Mari Doerner, Attorney at Law, including any jury trials as calendared by the Skagit County Clerk's Office. The Agreement shall commence on September 1, 2015, and continue until August 31, 2016.

# e) **PUBLIC WORKS**:

- 7. Resolution calling for a public hearing regarding the proposed establishment of Policies and Procedures for the creation of Railroad Quiet Zones. The public hearing is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, September 15, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible.
- 8. Resolution awarding the bid for the Bayhill Detention Pond Fence Replacement Project #WA402190 (a Drainage Utility project) to Discount Fence in the amount of \$10,906.42.
- 9. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Skagit River System Cooperative to allow Skagit County and Skagit River System Cooperative to partner with each other on projects. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2017. Skagit County will be reimbursed for providing its work force, materials, and equipment.

The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2015. Compensation shall not exceed \$11,250.
