5. Advertising Agreement with Skagit Publishing to provide advertising services as requested by various departments. Compensation shall not exceed \$25,000 and is based on a rate schedule. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 31, 2025 and shall continue until August 1, 2026.

c) **BUDGET AND FINANCE:**

6. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with WSU NWREC to award \$750,000 of Economic Development/Public Facilities Projects grant funds to support Plant Growth Facility Phase 2A and 2B. The Agreement commenced on June 16, 2025 pursuant to Resolution No. R20250137 and ends on June 30, 2026.

d) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

- 7. Vendor Services Agreement with Sunshine Painters, LLC to paint the interior building spaces at the Skagit County Transfer Station located at 14104 Ovenell Road in Mount Vernon. Compensation shall not exceed \$10,860. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and shall continue until December 31, 2025.
- 8. Amendment No. 3 to Standard AIA B103 Architect Agreement No. C20240133 with Carletti Architects P.S. to provide design services for the Skagit County Administration Building 3rd Floor Remodel Project located at 700 South 2nd Street in Mount Vernon. This Amendment increases compensation by \$5,400 for additional design services required for requested changes to drawings and specifications. Total compensation shall not exceed \$399,383. The term remains the same and shall continue until project completion in 2025. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
- 9. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20250135 with H.E. Solutions, LLC dba Custom Energy Consultants to provide required forms and submittals to comply with the State of Washington Clean Buildings Act. This Amendment increases the scope of work and funding for professional services to include work for one additional building previously thought to be exempt. Compensation is increased by \$12,813 for a new total not to exceed \$51,666. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2025. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 10. Amendment No. 2 to AIA Standard Form Agreement No. C20250059 with TRICO Companies to provide all labor, materials, and supervision services for tenant improvements on the 3rd floor of the Administration Building located at 700 South 2nd Street in Mount Vernon. This Amendment updates the Scope of Work to reflect floorplan changes needed once conditions were exposed or identified during the course of work. Compensation is increased from \$2,332,248 to an amount not to exceed \$2,448,505 plus applicable tax. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2025. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect.

e) HUMAN RESOURCES:

11. Client Services Agreement with Benefitfocus.com, Inc. to produce and mail confirmation statements for employee's open enrollment selections. Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$1,651.50 plus postage. The Agreement shall commence on December 1, 2025 and shall continue until December 31, 2025.

The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2027. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
- 17. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20250051 with Consejo Counseling and Referral Services to provide outpatient behavioral health services to eligible Skagit County residents. This Amendment increases compensation by \$12,000 for a new total compensation amount not to exceed \$32,000 to continue serving clients through the end of the year. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2025. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
