**COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE:**

**BUDGET & FINANCE:**

2. Amendment No. 1 to Interlocal Agreement **No. C20030090** between Skagit County and the La Conner Chamber of Commerce, which changes the specific scope of services within the original agreement to include printing of visitor guides. All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.

**FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:**

3. Quit Claim Deed transferring the County's parking lot located within the City's new Multimodal project to the City of Mount Vernon in exchange for two other City parking lots, which have already been transferred to the County.

**HUMAN SERVICES:**

4. Personal Services Agreement with Compass Health to provide substance abuse and mental health services to clients in Skagit County with co-occurring disorders during the period July 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003 for a maximum amount of \$25,000.

**PLANNING & PERMIT CENTER:**

**YOUTH & FAMILY SERVICES:**

8. Personal Services Agreement with DeLlamas & Associates (Joan DeLlamas) to provide a variety of drug and/or alcohol assessments, counseling and treatment as a stipulation for diversion from court. The agreement shall commence on January 11, 2003 and continue through January 31, 2004. Compensation shall not exceed a yearly rate of \$10,000.
9. Personal Services Agreement with Christopher Murray & Associates to evaluate the incidence of over-representation of minority youth within the Juvenile Justice system in each of five counties within the northwest Washington region, including Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom Counties. The agreement shall commence on September 2, 2003 and continue through December 31, 2003. Compensation is not to exceed \$7,750.

The additional time is necessary in order for SCD technicians to complete the planning and paperwork necessary for several landowners to qualify for cost-share assistance from the County for the installation of best management practices pursuant to the Ag-Critical Areas Ordinance.
14. Temporary Right-of-Entry Construction Agreement between Skagit County and Arnold Heskett Post 132 American Legion, owner of Parcel No. P70521. This agreement gives the County and its assigns the right to enter upon said land for the purpose of performing road construction improvements for Main Street in Concrete. No compensation is being paid.
15. Temporary Right-of-Entry Construction Agreement between Skagit County and Edwin E. & Lois E. Oliver, owners of Parcel No. P70710. This agreement gives the County and its assigns the right to enter upon said land for the purpose of performing road construction improvements for Main Street in Concrete. No compensation is being paid.
16. Temporary Right-of-Entry Construction Agreement between Skagit County and John Hohn, owner of Parcel No. P70498. This agreement gives the County and its assigns the right to enter upon said land for the purpose of performing road construction improvements for Main Street in Concrete. No compensation is being paid.
17. Local Agency Standard Consultant Agreement with Northwest Hydraulic Consultants, Inc., which will allow for the pier scour, evaluation and protection of the North Fork Skagit River Bridge #40037. The Agreement shall commence on September 22, 2003 and continue through December 31, 2004. Compensation is not expected to exceed \$15,000.
