Funding Agreement with Burlington-Edison School District to facilitate the safe reopening of schools and advance educational access and mitigate transmission of COVID-19 in the school environment, as described in Resolution No. R202001+9978. Through this contract, the County will distribute funds provided by Section 601(a) of the Social Security Act, as added by Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES Act") via the Washington State Department of Commerce, Skagit County Contract No. C20200207. Compensation shall not exceed \$175,150. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until November 20, 2020.
- 7. Funding Agreement with Concrete School District to facilitate the safe reopening of schools and advance educational access and mitigate transmission of COVID-19 in the school environment, as described in Resolution No. R20200178. Through this contract, the County will distribute funds provided by Section 601(a) of the Social Security Act, as added by Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES Act") via the Washington State Department of Commerce, Skagit County Contract No. C20200207. Compensation shall not exceed \$25,400. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until November 20, 2020.
- 8. Funding Agreement with Helping Hands Food Bank to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures by providing a means for food delivery to residents and to increase access to food bank services for residents who have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Through this contract, the County will distribute funds provided by Section 601(a) of the Social Security Act, as added by Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES Act") via the Washington State Department of Commerce, Skagit County Contract No. C20200207. Amendment No. 1 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20200352 with Lumenal Lighting for the provision of labor, materials, equipment and supervision for the installation of Light Emitting Diode (LED) fixtures and lamps at the Skagit County Transfer Station. This Amendment increases compensation by \$7,868.42 for additional lighting inside the Vactor Waste Building. Total compensation shall not exceed \$58,429.42 plus applicable sales tax. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect, including the term which continues to January 11, 2021.
- 10. Amendment No. 2 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20200188 with Atwork Commercial Enterprises, LLC to provide services for vegetation management of riparian restoration sites, stormwater detention facilities, drainage easements and rights of way, and one closed landfill site in Skagit County. This Amendment increases compensation by \$375.18 after increasing the amount of miscellaneous vegetation management work and removing Site 11, Franklin Road, from the Scope of Work. Total compensation shall not exceed \$141,916.54. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect including the term that continues until December 31, 2021.
- 19. Amendment No. 3 to Interlocal Cooperative Agreement No. C20190004 with Skagit Conservation District for the design, plans, and specifications for the removal of the Maddox Creek Culvert Fish Passage Barrier Project. This Amendment increases compensation by \$4,000 to allow for completion of project and construction management. Total compensation shall not exceed \$21,700. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect including the termination date of December 31, 2020.
- 20. Change Order #4 to Construction Contract No. C20200282 with Williamson Construction, LLC for the Maddox Creek Culvert Removal Project #WA402227 to improve fish passage and restore the surrounding topography. This Amendment increases compensation by \$4,907 for additional material that needed to be removed from the project site. Total compensation shall not exceed \$512,391.84. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect including the term that expires after one year, or project acceptance.
- 21. Amendment No. 4 to Local Agency Agreement with Natural Systems Design, Skagit County Contract No. C20180094, to support the management and administration of flood, stormwater, and drainage projects. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement by one additional year, continuing until December 31, 2021. Compensation remains the same and shall not exceed \$275,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
- 22. Amendment No. 3 to Local Agency Professional Services Consultant Agreement No. C20170472 with Northwest Hydraulic Consultants to perform engineering, design, and planning services aimed at providing

flood relief in the Skagit River delta and Samish River floodplain. This Amendment extends the Agreement from December 31, 2020 to December 31, 2022 and increases compensation by \$154,059. The new compensation amount shall not exceed \$554,059. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
