

Skagit County Legislative Report March 3, 2019

While Governor Jay Inslee prepared to announce that he is running for U.S. President, the fiscal committees of the Legislature met late into the evening voting on bills to meet the fiscal committee cutoff deadline. Fiscal committees failed to pass hundreds of bills prior to the fiscal committee cutoff deadline and are technically no longer under consideration this session. However, a bill is never truly "dead" since, with a simple majority, the Legislature may waive its own rules. Additionally, some bills have been designated "necessary to implement the budget" (NTIB) and are not subject to cutoff deadlines. Such instances are rare and after Friday, there are significantly fewer bills under consideration. The House and Senate also found time last week to pass handful of bills and refer them to the opposite chamber for consideration. This included the Clean Energy bill (SB 5116), which is a major policy priority for the Governor and democratic caucuses. For the next week and a half the Legislature will be "on the floor" voting on bills that are still under consideration. Bills need to pass out of their chamber of origin (i.e. House bills need to pass the House; Senate bills need to pass the Senate) by 5PM on Wednesday, March 13th.

Ongoing Operating Budget Discussions

Budget writers have begun meeting behind closed doors to begin developing the 2019-21 Operating Budget. While the Operating Budget won't be released until after the Economic and Revenue Forecast Council's March 20th report, Democrats are beginning to relay four cost-drivers that are putting a squeeze on the state budget:

- (1) As part of the *McCleary* solution adopted in the 2017 legislative session, K-12 education funding was significantly increased; however, local levies were capped causing 1/3 of the state's 295 school districts to now face a fiscal cliff. These school districts are calling on the Legislature to fix the problem, at a significant cost. <u>Click here</u> for more details.
- (2) In 2017 the Legislature indicated an intent to establish the State Employee Benefits Board (SEBB) to manage health insurance options for K-12 employees starting January 1, 2020. The price tag for the program is \$900 million. <u>Click here</u> for more details.
- (3) The Governor negotiated collective bargaining agreements for general government state employees and then proposed to fund the agreements in his proposed budget. Fully funding the negotiated agreements will cost over \$1 billion. <u>Click here</u> for more details.
- (4) Over the legislative interim, the state entered into a settlement related to the *Trueblood* case to provide competency restoration services in a more timely manner. To comply, the Legislature will need to reform the state's mental health system the total cost of which has not yet been determined.

Despite state revenue collections increasing \$4.5 billion more than forecasted, Democrats indicate that when the above cost-drivers are accounted for there is a \$3.5 to 4 billion budget shortfall. To close that shortfall, enhance existing programs, and invest in new programs, Democrats propose to increase taxes to generate new revenue. New tax proposals include instituting a capital gains tax, increasing the B&O tax on professional services, and changing the state's flat-rate real estate excise tax to a graduated rate. The amount of state general fund revenue available and/or generated will not become clear until budget proposals are released in mid-March.

Skagit County Requests for the Week

The focus of this week will be on floor action rather than committee hearings. GTHGA has submitted requests for all of the county's budget priorities listed below, and we will continue to advocate for them while legislators are on the floor.
