MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, September 17, 1984, with Commissioners Norris, Mansfield, and Rohrer present.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Myron Williams, Doug Rowell, and John Falavolito, representing the United Way, were present to request the Board's adoption of a resolution supporting the United Way effort.

Commissioner Mansfield motioned to adopt the resolution supporting the United Way effort. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously. (Resolution #10190)

SIGNATURE - GRANT APPLICATION TO NORTHWEST REGIONAL COUNCIL - SENIOR SERVICES/HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

Dr. J. K. Neils, of the Health Department, presented for the Board's signature a proposal for the Senior Health Screening program.

Jon Aarstad, Director of the Parks, Recreation, and Senior Services Department, presented for the Board's signature proposals to the Northwest Regional Council for the Skagit County Senior Employment Program, Skagit County Nutrition Project, Skagit County Retired Senior Volunteer Program, and Senior Information and Assistance Program.

Also presented for the Board's signature was a budget for the Skagit Information and Assistance contract amended to include the Respite Care Demonstration Project case management services. The Board signed cover letters to be presented with the above proposals.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Jon Aarstad requested direction from the Board on the use of interest earned on the multi-purpose facility money. The Board instructed Mr. Aarstad to include suggested items on the change order proposal.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Robert Taylor, Administrative Officer, presented the following items:

1. Following discussion of a letter received from Jim Rice, of the City of Anacortes, Commissioner Mansfield motioned to schedule a public hearing to discuss Skagit County's community development and housing needs on Monday, September 24, 1984, at 10:00 a.m. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
2. The Board approved for signature a letter to the Department of Ecology advising that Skagit County will require shoreline permit application and review for projects requesting temporary modification of water quality standards for the purpose of applying herbicides for weed/algae growth control on shorelines of the State within Skagit County. The letter requests that any such proposals or inquiries be referred to the County to expedite the permit process at the local level.
3. The Board reviewed the following Taxpayer's Claims for Reduction of Assessment on Destroyed Real or Personal Property:
  - a. Charles J. Larsen, 1413 11th Street, Anacortes, Washington 98221, in the amount of \$300 for tax year 1986 because a shed was dilapidated.
  - b. Donald M. Jagger, 500 Borseth, Sedro Woolley, Washington 98284, in the amount of \$2,500 for tax year 1986 because a truck accident destroyed a portion of a building.
  - c. Norrie Estvold, 1003 15th Street, Anacortes, Washington 98221, in the amount of \$43,240 for tax year 1986 because of fire.

Commissioner Mansfield motioned to approve the above listed Taxpayer's Claims, as recommended by the Assessor. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.



4. Commissioner Mansfield motioned to approve the Record of the Proceedings for Tuesday, September 11, 1984. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
5. Commissioner Mansfield motioned to approve Warrants #35558 through #35612 in the amount of \$40,693.77. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously. (R-36)


Commissioner Mansfield motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
